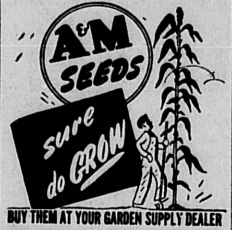

HOUSING SITUATION IN TORRANCE CRITICAL AS HUNDREDS NEED HOMES

Torrance's housing problem again has reached critical proportions, according to Pat MacDonnell, area manager for eight War Housing Centers in the coastal area.

Veterans' Center Set up by L.A. War Chest

Setting an example to the rest of the nation in their original plan to coordinate services for homecoming veterans, key leaders of government, labor, veterans organizations and other groups met last week at Los Angeles Biltmore Hotel to give the "go ahead" signal for the establishment of the Veterans Services Center.

More than 500 representative men and women present gave their unqualified approval of the full cooperation to provide central headquarters for the advice and aid to returning service men and women to help them readjust to civilian life and spare them days of "shopping around" for assistance which is available to them.

The Veterans Center tentatively has been planned near the United States Employment Office in Los Angeles, and according to Lynn D. Mowat, general manager of the War Chest, one of the five organizations sponsoring the center, branches may be expected to be established for other areas as conditions warrant.

Paul K. Yost, who presided at the meeting, was named chairman of a committee of 15 who will immediately proceed to make the center a working reality.

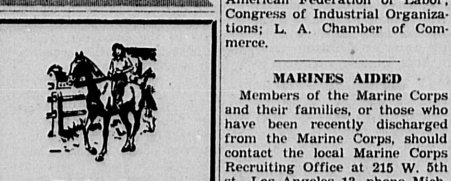
In spite of the fact that the agency has been in operation for a long time, there still are many landlords and brokers who do not understand how it operates.

PRIORITY PLAN OF HIRING ENDS BOTTLENECKS

During the first week of "priority referrals" of most male workers in the Los Angeles area under the government's new manpower program, 10 percent of the critical war production bottlenecks were broken, according to announcement today by E. C. Rinehart, acting Southern California manpower director.

Other highlights of the program's operation in Los Angeles and Orange counties, as reported to Director Rinehart by Thomas C. Campbell, War Manpower Commission director for this two-county area:

1. The program is proving effective in alleviating critical manpower shortages in war plants.

2. Public reaction is "generally good" with some complaint, however, from employers who are having a more difficult job securing male workers as result of their diversion to jobs of highest importance to the war effort.

3. Workers generally are "responding conscientiously" to the requirements of the program readily accepting jobs offered them by the U. S. Employment Service and other referral agencies.

4. Without increased personnel, the U.S.E.S. offices have been under considerable strain through the load was "evened off" after the first few days of packed offices and long lines of waiting applicants.

5. Fifteen percent of the increased load being handled by the offices is due to the referral of male workers to the offices by employers for clearance.

During the first week 75 percent of such workers were sent to high priority jobs rather than being sent back to the interested employer.
