"We are greatly in need of help to man the residential teams," Mr. Bowen declared. "We are hopeful that the women of the American Legion Auxiliary, Parent-Teacher Association, clubs and church groups will come forward and work with us for a few hours."

"Everybody is busy, I know," he said, "but there is no slackening of all-out effort in any of the war theatres. We at home must take on more work to see that full support is given our fighting forces, our Allies and that home conditions may be kept right. It is up to everyone of us to do what we can on the home front to see the job through."
