Use Old Car License Number On 'A' Coupons

Despite the fact that the state in preparing to issue new 1945 automobile license plates late in December, all motorists receiving new "A" book or other ration coupons valid into next year should endorse all such coupons with their present car license number.

This advice was given today by F. W. Daniels, chief clerk, local ration board. California, together with most other states of the nation, is now preparing to issue the first new car license plates put out in several years. Distributions of the new 1945 plates, OPA has been informed, will be made toward the end of December.

Gasoline ration coupons of several series are dated to be valid well into 1945. Federal regulations require that all ration coupons to be valid must be endorsed with the license number and state of registration of the car for which they are issued.

The pending change in car license numbers will not affect this requirement, Daniels said.

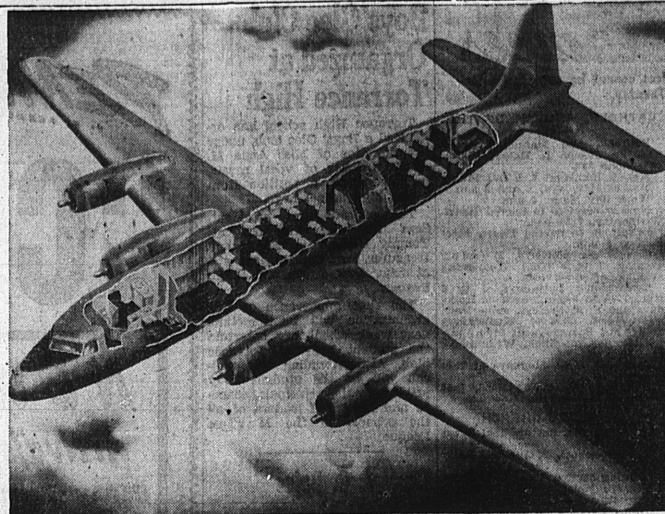

Torrance Man Finds Sailor Dead In Car

Raymond C. Shaver, 1569 W. 218th st., Torrance, foreman, inspecting fruit cars at the harbor, Monday morning opened the door of one car to find 20-year-old Orval E. Oliver, U.S.N., dead inside.

Oliver had been missing since the previous Thursday. It was apparent he had perished from suffocation after lighting a fire in the car in an effort to burn a hole in it and attract someone who could release him.

Harbor police officers said Oliver was working at the docks during leave and someone probably unwittingly locked him in the car. The car was not fed. It remained unopened until Shaver went to inspect it previous to loading it with bananas.

Oliver enlisted from Tacoma, Wash., where his mother resides. He leaves a young widow, according to authorities.

To assure timely delivery of gifts, which must not be more than 36 inches in length and girth nor weigh more than five pounds, they must be mailed between now and Oct. 15, the warning stated.

Christmas cards may be mailed anytime prior to or after the Oct. 15 deadline, provided they are in sealed envelopes.

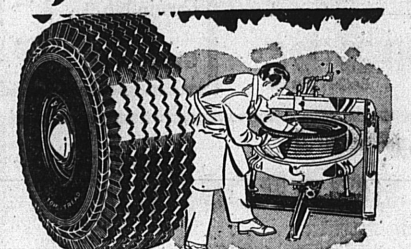
