

Most Progressive Since Hiram Johnson, Thomas Says of Gov. Warren's Legislative Program

Assemblyman Vincent Thomas, representing the 68th District, declared that the message of Gov. Earl Warren to the legislature recently "is considered the most progressive program since the time of Gov. Hiram Johnson's reign at the capitol."

In a letter to Grover C. Whyte, publisher of the Torrance Herald, he said:

"The governor requested compulsory health insurance, denounced 'repressive' labor legislation, backed the expansion of the unemployment insurance act, urged the licensing and regulating of private hospitals, stressed the need for progressive legislation which would better the care of the crippled, blind and

suggested the creation of a standing commission to make a steady fight against racial discrimination.

"He pointed out the importance of progressive legislation because California is now the tower of production, and a haven for peoples from other states. Many bills are now in the hopper filling the gap for all of the above subjects, and most of all the legislature and its functions have been streamlined for the first time—this took four years of committee work, changing the rules and committee organizations."

Assemblyman Thomas was appointed vice chairman of the Assembly Committee on Fish and Game, vice chairman of the Assembly Committee on Constitutional Amendments, and was named to the Assembly Committee on Transportation and Commerce.
