New Draft Rules Involving Men Under 30 Are Explained by WPB

Bouthland WPB officials today were operating under new draft rules providing for certification of requests for occupational deferment for what was termed "a vital hard cohe" of workers under 30 who are engaged in war production and supporting activities,
