More Ration
Stamps Good
As of July 1

Five more blue ration stamps for processed foods, and five more red stamps for meats and fats, all in War Ration Book Four, became good on Sunday, July 1.

Each of the stamps is worth 10 points, making a total of 50 blue points and 50 red points, and all stamps that became good on July 1 can be used through October 31.

The new blue stamps are J-1, K-1, L-1, M-1 and N-1; Red, A-1, B-1, C-1, D-1 and E-1. Stamps retired last month are red stamps E-2 through J-2, and blue stamps N-2 through S-2, which are not good after June 30.

Sugar stamp 36, in War Ration Book Four, will continue good for five pounds of sugar through August 31.
