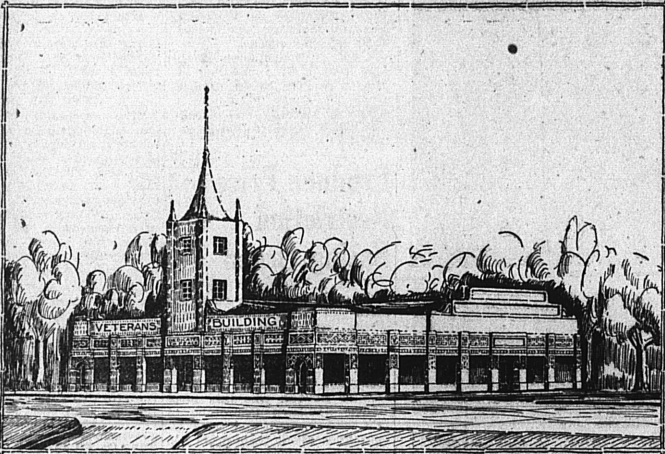


Your Help is Needed to Create This Living Memorial for Torrance and Torrance Area Veterans--- **VETERANS MEMORIAL BUILDING**

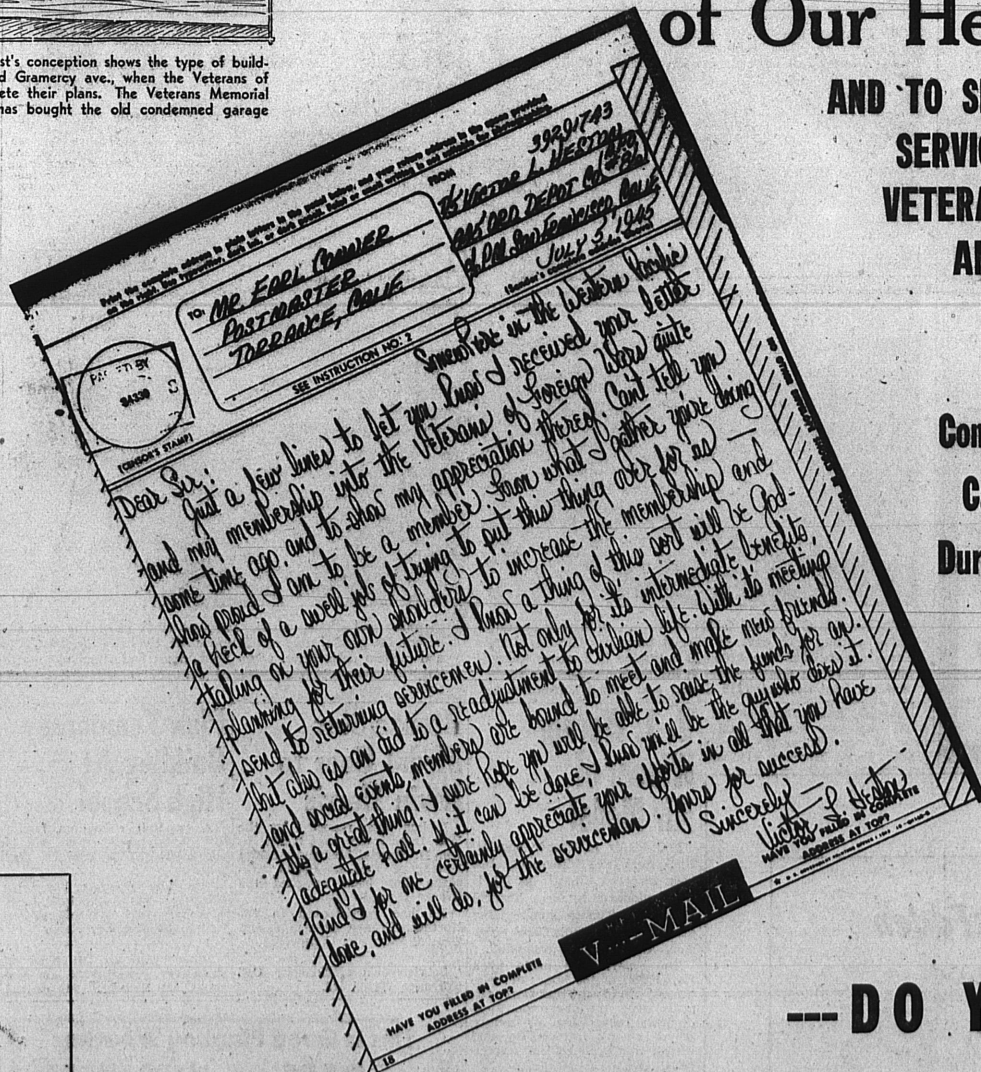
