Jap Evacuees Go Eastward

More than half the Japanese-Americans who left the War Relocation Authority's eight centers during the first half of this year, went East rather than return to the Pacific Coast, Paul G. Robertson, WRA area supervisor for Southern California announced today.

Of 15,907 resettlers, only 36 per cent returned to the Pacific Coast and less than 11 per cent of these came to the nine Southern California counties, Robertson said.
