

Norris Hails Columbia Plan For Expansion

Kenneth T. Norris hailed an announcement that the United States Steel Corp. will extend its facilities at Torrance and Pittsburg, Cal., as presaging benefits to western fabricators.

Norris, chairman of the steel committee of the Western States Council, industrial group, organized to further Coast development, pointed out that the recent withdrawal of U. S. Steel as a potential bidder for the government-owned steel plant at Geneva, Utah, accents the company's statement of enlargement plans for its Coast plants.

"We are pleased that the U. S. Steel Corp. will increase its Pacific Coast production capacity in order to serve the expanding requirements of industry," Norris said, "particularly in the making of flat rolled steel."

"The fact that the corporation will center its western production on the Pacific Coast is probably due to the high freight rates on finished steel products from Geneva to coast markets."

Norris emphasized that his committee is neutral regarding bidders on the Geneva plant now up for disposal by the government. "Our aim," he declared, "is ultimate operation of both Fontana and Geneva by private interests pledged to maintenance of lower steel prices in the West."
