UNRRA will ship the clothes, shoes and bedding contributed in January for free distribution to the needy and destitute in liberated Europe, the Philippines and the Far East. UNRRA recently announced that every pound of the elothing contributed by the American people just a few months ago will be in the hands of the war-sufferers before Christmas. All this clothing, UNRRA officials said, will have to be shipped from this country by October 30. UNRRA is also shipping clothing contributed to collections for war relief in Canada, New Zealand and Australia.
