

Torrance District Welfare Council Receives Reports For Month's Work

The Torrance District Welfare Council, the War Chest working body for this area, held its monthly meeting Monday evening, Nov. 19. Reports were given by Mrs. Linden Johnson for Lomita, Joel Hagberg for Torrance, Mrs. J. Compton for the Torrance Canteen, Ted Meier for the Y.M.C.A., and the Rev. Paul Moore Wheeler for the Youth Survey committee and the district planning committee.

The district office serves the needs of the general public of Torrance, Lomita, Palos Verdes, Gardena and the Los Angeles City Strip in the fields of visiting nursing, family welfare, Y.M.C.A., boy and girl scouts, sickness, social problems, public assistance and character building agencies.

Ted Meier of the Y.M.C.A. gave the council a detailed report of his work. The "Y" now sponsors three Hi-Y's, the youth canteen known as Tartar Town, and is now organizing a church basketball league. Practice has already been started evenings at the Torrance Hi gym.

Meier also pointed out that the Hi-Y boys provided 90 per cent of the leadership this summer at the "Y" camps for Torrance boys.

Upon the vote of the district planning committee meeting at Huntington Park, the name of all offices was changed from "service centers," to "district welfare centers." This was done to avoid conflict with the centers set up for aid to the returning service men. The Torrance office from now on will be known as the "Torrance District Welfare Center."

The demand, by returning service men for public assistance as reported by James Caldwell, of the Veterans Center, prompted the council to ask for a full time representative of the County Bureau of Public Assistance to be located at the Torrance Center.

Miss Esther Maxwell reported for the Christmas Clearing Bureau Committee. To avoid duplication in Christmas giving, the various organizations are asked to clear names through the Welfare Center office, which will have a complete list of needy families.

Pipe Line Is Authorized By Los Angeles
An ordinance granting the Union Oil Company of California a pipe line franchise on certain streets in Wilmington was adopted Monday by the Los Angeles city council.

In addition to maintaining existing oil and gasoline pipe lines installed under other franchises, the company was granted permission to construct a new 18 inch line to transport dry gas from the Dominguez Field to the company's refinery at Wilmington, the gas to replace the use of oil as fuel at the refinery.
