County and Cities Received Net Of \$6,847,076 In State Gas Tax Funds

Los Angeles county and cities in the county received a net of \$6,847,076 in gas tax and motor vehicle fees from 'the state of California during the fiscal 1945, California Taxpayers' association said today, making public its study of state payments to local governments for highway purposes.

The .county's apportionmen from the gas tax amounted to \$5,155,245, of which \$1,600,63 was withheld by the state fo a payment on the unemploymen relief loan owed by the county to the state. Net to the county from the gas tax was \$\$,554,606 The county in addition receive \$1,681,835 from registration an weight fees. Cities in the county received \$1,610,633 from the state for street purposes and the state is required to spend a like sum for state highway purpose in cities.

Motor vehicle and fuel tar monies apportioned by the stat to the counties and cities in California for fiscal 1945 totalle \$21,958,666, with \$24,30,828 with held for repayment of the unem ployment relief loan indebtednes of twenty-six counties, or a ne of \$19,528,038. Gas tax monie for the counties totalled \$14,292 \$89, from which the \$2,430,82 relief loan payment was with held, making a net to the counties from fuel taxes of \$11,862 041. Registration and weight fee apportioned to the counties to talled \$4,092,780. Cities receive \$3,573,217 in direct apportion ment from the state and the state is required to spend a lik sum for state highway purpose within cities.

"At the end of 1940 ther were 2,955,952 motor vehicle registered as fee paid in Cal fornia. At June 30, 1945, ther were 2,967,533 fee paid moto vehicles registered in the state Reports are that the state department of motor vehicles i making plans for the registration of large numbers of additional vehicles in California during 1946.
