posed of by the holders as they see fit. Director d'Orr pointed out that the red tokens are government property and must be collected to prevent their misuse. Most of such tokens, he said, are held by the trade and by ration banks, and, if surrendered promptly, the government agency will be enabled to rapidly wind up all matters pertaining to the terminated ration program. The tokens need not be count-ed, d'Orr said, and may be placed either in the standard container or in a sealed enve-lope. Naturally, he pointed out, no ration credit will be given for surrendered tokens.
