#### O. M. Baker **Given 20 Days** In County Jail

Oliver M. Baker, 1211 Ell Prado, Monday was sentenced to 20 days in the County Jail, Nov. 30, with six months suspended and an order to stay out of Torrance, by City Judge John. Shidler. Baker, who originally was charged with child beating, denied the accusation brought by his wife, Mrs. Betty Baker. Mrs. Baker reported to police that although she had not actually seen her husband strike their three-year-old son, Richard, about the head and face, she was confident that he had. She stated that while she was in another room of the apartment with their other child, Richard ran into her room screeming that his daddy had beat him. Welts about the youngster's face tonfirmed that he had been beaten, police believed. The charge of child beating was reduced to simple assault when no witness could be produced.
