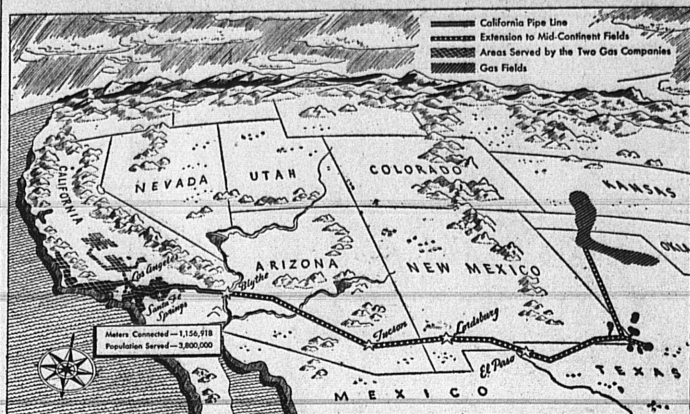

GAS PIPELINE TO LINK TEXAS—CALIFORNIA



Proposed natural gas pipeline, now before Railroad Commission, will extend 1,000 miles to Mid-Continent gas fields. Project, designed to safeguard Southern California's future domestic fuel requirements, will bring natural gas to Los Angeles area, and give employment to 3,000 workers.

Proposed Pipeline From Blythe To Los Angeles Gets Hearing

State Railroad Commission hearings on an application to build a 214-mile pipeline from Blythe to Los Angeles, as part of a 1,000-mile pipeline project to tap natural gas reserves of Texas' vast Mid-Continent fields opened Dec. 17. Commission President L. Harold Anderson and Commissioner Ira H. Rowell are presiding at the hearings.

According to the petition filed jointly by the Southern California Gas Company and the Southern Counties Gas Company, the 30-year contract has been entered into as one of the important steps being made by the two gas companies in an effort to provide an adequate long-time supply of natural gas for Southern California. Until now, these two gas companies have served the public with natural gas from California sources only.

Present estimates indicate that unless additional sources of natural gas are made available by the year 1949, the total market will be able to absorb 263 million cubic feet a day more than is estimated to be available from existing facilities and sources.

HERONS INLAND

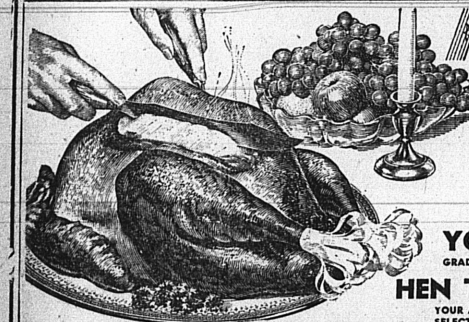
