Pupils Of Torrance On Short-Day Sessions As Building Stands Idle

While many pupils of Torrance elementary school are on so-called "half day sessions," a federally sponsored building on the school grounds containing two classrooms is not in use. This fact was brought to light in view of the statement of Assemblyman Julian Beck, of Los Angeles, that "11,000 Los Angeles school children are on half time schedule because of the shortage of school buildings."

Beck is trying to get state funds to help local districts provide buildings, but in the Torrance case, it is pointed out, a building is provided to handle the Torrance elementary short-session students—but it is not being utilized.

Likewise, according to Principal B. J. Strand, there are sufficient teachers there to handle the additional classes.

Rep. King Suggested For Senate

Rep. Cecil R. King was seen as a "drafted" candidate for California's United States Senator, following a general assembly meeting of 478 delegates of the United AFL's Political Action Arm of Los Angeles county.

The delegates, representing more than 500,000 unionists, unanimously selected Congressman King, of the 17th district which includes Torrance and Lomita to run for the senatorship now held by appointee William R. Knowland.

AFL officials said that King was the only man for the position and that America needs more men like him in public office.

King was reported to have recently returned from a confidential mission in the near east for President Harry Truman, and will be contacted immediately on the AFL proposed campaign.

The labor leaders declared that henceforth they will seek to install a "good man" in office whenever other political groups nominate extreme "left or right" candidates.
