**RESOLUTION NO. 1752**  
RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD JANUARY 15, 1946 WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID DISTRICT OF THE PROPOSITION OF INCURRING A DEBT BY THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF SUCH DISTRICT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$150,000.00 TO PAY THE COSTS AND EXPENSES OF ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING WATER WORKS FOR SAID DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, on October 29, 1945, a petition was filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Torrance requesting that proceedings be taken under the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled "An act to provide for the formation of districts within municipalities for the acquisition, construction or extension of water works, water systems or water distribution systems; for the issuance, sale and payment of bonds of such districts to meet the cost of such water works, water systems or water distribution systems; and for the acquisition, construction or extension of such water works, water systems or water distribution systems," approved April 26, 1935, for the formation of Municipal Water District No. 1 of the City of Torrance for the purpose of creating an indebtedness, to be represented by bonds of said district, the proceeds from the sale of which shall be used to pay the costs and expenses of acquiring and constructing water works as described therein and as hereinafter set forth, and said petition was signed by not less than ten percent (10%) of the qualified electors residing within the territory proposed by said petition to be formed into a municipal water district under said act, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said petition and said act, the City Council of said city on November 27, 1945, passed and adopted an ordinance, numbered Ordinance No. 365, containing the matters and things prescribed by said act and declaring the intention of said City Council to call an election in said district for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said district the proposition of authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds of said district in the manner provided for in said act, and in the manner and for the purposes set forth in said ordinance of intention and, thereafter said ordinance was duly published as provided by law, and

WHEREAS, the hearing provided for in said ordinance has been duly and regularly held at the time and place fixed therefor and no protests or objections have been made and the City Council at the time and place fixed for said hearing took evidence upon the allegations of the petition, and that all the property in the district would be benefited by the proposed water works described in said ordinance and upon all other matters upon which evidence is necessary, and the City Council of said city has acquired jurisdiction to proceed further in accordance with the provisions of said act;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Torrance, California, does hereby resolve, determine and order as follows:

Section 1. That a special election be held and the same is hereby called and ordered to be held on Tuesday, January 15, 1946, within Municipal Water District No. 1 of the City of Torrance, the exterior boundaries of which district are described in said ordinance of intention and hereinafter set forth, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said district the proposition of incurring a debt by the issuance of bonds of said district in the amount of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) for the purposes set forth in said ordinance of intention and hereinafter stated.

Section 2. That the exterior boundaries of said district are particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the south boundary of the City of Torrance at the northeast corner of Tract No. 10306, as shown on map recorded in Book 173, Pages 12 and 14 of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County, California; thence northerly along the easterly line of said Tract No. 10306, along the easterly line of Tract No. 10304 as shown on map recorded in Book 160, Pages 37 to 41 of Maps, Records of Los Angeles County, California; thence northerly along the easterly line of said Tract No. 10302 as shown on map recorded in Book 149, Pages 97 to 100 of said Maps, and along the easterly line of

Tract 10300 as shown on map recorded in Book 146, Pages 86 to 89 of said Maps, and its northerly prolongation to a corner in the boundary line of the City of Torrance; thence northerly along said city boundary line to a corner therein; thence easterly along said city boundary line and the easterly prolongation thereof to a point in the southerly line of Sepulveda Boulevard; thence easterly along the southerly line of Sepulveda Boulevard in its various courses to the northeast corner of Tract No. 2200, as shown on map recorded in Book 26, Pages 19 and 20 of said Maps; thence southerly along the easterly line of said Tract No. 2200 to the northwestern corner of Tract No. 397, as shown on map recorded in Book 14, Page 112 of said Maps; thence southerly along the westerly boundary line of said Tract No. 397 to a corner in the boundary line of the City of Torrance; thence following along said city boundary line in its various courses, southerly, westerly, southerly, westerly, and southerly to the southeast corner of Tract No. 9765 as shown on map recorded in Book 170, Pages 10 to 12 of said Maps; thence continuing along the said city boundary line westerly, northwesterly, and westerly to the point of beginning. (In all places in which the boundary line of the City of Torrance is mentioned or referred to in this description, the line so mentioned or referred to is the boundary line of the city as the same existed on October 1, 1945, and all references to Maps, Books, or records in said description refer to records of Los Angeles County, California, on file in the office of the County Recorder of said County.)

Section 3. That the objects and purposes for which said proposed indebtedness is to be incurred and the nature of the water works contemplated thereby is as follows, to wit: the acquisition and construction of water works, for supplying said district and the inhabitants thereof with water for domestic, agricultural, industrial or other purposes; said water works to consist of a water supply main extending along Pacific Coast Highway from the water main of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California at Walnut Street and Pacific Coast Highway to approximately the westerly line of Lot 8, Meadow Park Tract, as shown on map recorded in Book 18, Page 60, Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, California; the acquisition of an existing water distribution system (sometimes called the Quandt system) in said district, and the reconstruction of additional water distribution mains; and the acquisition and construction along the water distribution lines of fire hydrants, meters, and appurtenant works.

Section 4. That for the purpose of holding said election said Municipal Water District No. 1 shall constitute one election precinct; that the polling place for said precinct shall be Fire House, No. 3774 242nd Street, Torrance, that the following named persons, being competent and qualified electors of said district and said precinct are hereby appointed to act as election officers at said election and they shall hold and conduct said election and make return thereof in the manner provided by law, said officers are designated, inspector, judge and clerk, respectively, as follows: Inspector Leonore Gemoets Judge Nora Venable Clerk Ethel K. Derouin

Section 7. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution said election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding general municipal elections in said City of Torrance.

Section 8. That the City Council of said city shall meet and canvass the returns of said election at the usual place of meeting of said council, in the City Hall of said city on Tuesday, January 22, 1946, at the hour of eight (8) o'clock P.M.

Section 9. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution by a vote of at least three-fifths (3/5) of all the members of the City Council of said city and shall cause this resolution to be published twice in the TORRANCE HERALD, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Torrance. No other notice of such election need be given.

Shall that certain municipal water district known as Municipal Water District No. 1 of the City of Torrance, California, incur a bonded debt in the sum of \$150,000.00 to pay the costs and expenses of the acquisition and construction of water works, for supplying said district and the inhabitants thereof with water for domestic, agricultural, industrial or other purposes; said water works to consist of a water supply main extending along Pacific Coast Highway from the water main of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California at Walnut Street and Pacific Coast Highway to approximately the westerly line of Lot 8, Meadow Park Tract, as shown on map recorded in Book 18, Page 60, Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, California; the acquisition of an existing water distribution system (sometimes called the Quandt system) in said district, and the reconstruction of additional water distribution mains; and the acquisition and construction along the water distribution lines of fire hydrants, meters, and appurtenant works?
