## Herald To Carry Ad Of Tax Deeded Annual Chamber Properties On Sale March 18

Including 2186 Parcels of Real Estate, distributed in some 80 different communities, the country's second largest sale of tax. deceded proporties in recent years, tand the largest since that of October, 1944, will start Monday, March 18, H. L. Byram. County Tax Collector, announced today, The properties are being advertised beginning Feb. 21, in 71 different newspapers of the County, including the Torranee Herald.

Properties being offered for sale carry a total assessed valuation of \$533,195, but will go on the auction block at an aging greate minimum is figured on the basis of seven times the current year's taxes.

The sale in March will be the first of three and possibly four, such sales scheduled for this year, Byram stated. Three such sales were held in 1945, in Fébruary, August and December, at which 3481 properties were sold for a total income to the County of \$880,014. At the December sale bidding was so active that final selling prices ran nearly 50 per cent above assessed vauations.
