Io New Sales lax Los Angeles taxpayers will feel the first effects of the city's new revenue measures Saturday. May 11, when both the sales and the fabricators tax ordinances go into effect. The sales tax is a one-half cent on the dollar city tax on all retail purchases, which in addition to the two and one-nalf cent state sales tax will amount to three cents on a dol-ar for Los Angeles residents. The fabricators tax is a li-cense tax on manufacturers en-gaged in processing, repairing or servicing of merchandise, and who are not subject to business licenses. The fabricators will pay §12 on the first 12,000 or less of gross receipts, plus one dol-ar a year for each additional \$1000. Wholesalers and retailers busi-mess license tax ordinagees are due to go into effect on Jan nolesalers and retailers bus license tax ordinances ar


