Confronted with this problem, the Vocational Re-habilitation department of the Veterans Administration, in co-operation with the Supply div-sion, has acquired a large stock of tools from the War Assets Administration through a sur-plus transfer. Disabled veterans are being given priority in the distribution of the tools. The tools are from decomis-sioned war plants in Southern California. Many are not avail-






