Electronics Training For Youths Offered

With thousands of young men needed for training in electronics engineering, the navy today offers high school graduates and others who can qualify one of the greatest opportunities for advancement and technical education in its history.

That statement was made by Chief James C. Brown, the recruiter in charge of the navy recruiting station located at 112 So. Grevillea Park, Inglewood, Calif., following receipt of detailed information concerning the newly reorganized Electronics Technician's Mate program. Information from the Navy Department that thousands of young men are needed immediately to begin the one-year course in electronics was forwarded to the local recruiter by Commander J. M. LaFollette, officer in charge of navy recruiting in Southern California.

"The electronics training course offers young men an opportunity," the local recruiting officer said, "to earn college credit and at the same time become a skilled technician in a scientific field which is just beginning to be applied to commerce and industry."

Varicose Veins Discussed By Dr. Swartout

Varicose veins are greatly distended veins. The stretching of their walls is so great that the valves cannot work normally, and the blood flows through the veins very slowly. Such veins are common in the leg, below the knee, and appear as large, irregular blood channels just beneath the skin.

Most cases develop before the age of forty. Men are afflicted more frequently than women. In women, pregnancy and tumors in the pelvis may cause this condition. The wearing of tight bands or garters about the leg is often a cause. Occupations that require long hours of standing cause varicose veins in many persons.

Besides the aching in the leg, swelling, eczema of the skin of the leg and other complications may result from varicose veins. On account of the slow return of blood through these veins, the circulation in the leg is retarded and poor nutrition results with the possible formation of ulcers, commonly just above the ankle. These varicose ulcers are difficult to heal, and may return after healing has occurred. Neither the eczema nor the ulcers are benefited much by ointments, lotions or antiseptics, and if these are at all strong they may do harm.

MATHEMATICS AND ELECTRONICS TO BE U. OF C. EXTENSION

University of California Extension, in cooperation with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Union No. B-11, announces the opening this month of two special courses in mathematics and electronics. Both will meet at the Extension classroom center, 813 South Hill st. in downtown Los Angeles.

Beginning Fundamental Electronics in June 17 at 7 p. m. a course will have as instructor, E. H. Hulise, consulting and application engineer. Prerequisites for this course will be algebra, trigonometry and a working knowledge of electrical circuits. It will include 15 weekly Monday evening meetings. "Mathematics for Electricians and Radiomen" is the subject of the second course which opens Wednesday evening, June 19, with S. C. Andreae, electrical engineer, as instructor.
