retail trade workers are receiving 65 percent more pay now
than in 1939.

These wage increases do not
reflect the entire gain, however,
because most workers are now
putting in slightly more hours
than they did in 1939, and the
1946 wages were computed on
the basis of the 1939 work week,
the association said.
