## Highlights of the Armed Forces , Voluntary Recruitment Act

Enlistments for 1½, 2 or 3 years. (One-year enlistments permitted for men now in the Army with 6 or more menths of service.)
Enlistment age from 18 to 24 years, inclusive [17 with parents' consent], except for men naw in the Army, whe may re-enlist at any age, and former service men, depending on length of service.
A reenlistment bonus of \$50 for each year of active service since such benus was last paid, or since last entry into serv-ice, provided reenlistment is within 90 days after last honorable discharge.
Up to 90 days' paid furlough, de-

acys atter last honorable discharge. 4. Up to 90 days' paid furlough, de-pending on length of service, with travel paid to home and return, for men who reenlist within the prescribed time after discharge.

5. A thirty-day furlough each year with full pay. 6. Mustering - out pay (based upon length of service) to all men who are dis-charged to enlist or reenlist.

7. Option to retire at half pay for the rest of your life after 20 years' service-increasing to three-quarters pay after 30 yean' service. All previous active Federal military service counts toward retirement.

8. Benefits under the G. I. Bill of Rights for men who enlist on or before October 5, 1946. A 4year college, trade, or busi-ness school course with expenses paid, at the end of a 2-year enlistment.

9. Choice of branch of service and over-seas theater (of those still open) on 3-year enlistments.
