If Torrance decides on Re-dondo Beach high school district, to operate Torrance high school during the interim while machin-ery is being set in motion for formation of the Torrance Uni-fied School district, Torrance automatically will become a part of the new Junior College dis-trict formed on Tuesday. Even after Torrance forms the Unified School District, if she picks Redondo high school dis-trict rather than Los Angeles, her membership in the Junior college district will be binding.
