Eyes cannot be healthy in a body that is sick, and likewise when eyes are tired. Children have strong focus-ing muscles in their eyes but if there is a large amount of farsightedness they need, glass-es which will do the focusing for them and give their eyes a rest. If nearsighted, eyes are already focused for nearby ob-jects they become largy and un-healthy unless they get, the proper amount of focusing exer-cides.
