



Housewives do not need to be apprehensive over the price or the availability of turkey for the Thanksgiving fest, a government expert revealed.

"The Calfornia crop is just about normal," said L. B. San born, assistant county farm adviser, "and in addition there is a large holdover of cold storage turkey. The cold storage hold over has dropped from 135,000,000 pounds in Pebruary to 47,000,000 pounds in Pebruary to 47,000,000 pounds in October, but that still is a lot of turkey. Counting both storage and live birds, there seems to be about 4½ pounds available for each person."
