

## NO MEAT ON MONDAYS?

 SAN PEDRO UNION LEADER DEWANDS TORRANCE AREA MEAT MARKETS CLOSE ON MONDAYSFrank Kresnesky, President of the San Pedro Butaher Union controlling Torrance Area butcherrs, is demanding that we stop selling you meat on Mondays.

In your interest, responsible retail meat market operators are refusing this dictatorial demand.

Market operators will not conspire with union leaders to deprive you of meat counter service on Mondays. We do not believe these unions have the right to dictate which days of the week you may buy meat or which days market operators may sell you meat.

The meat market operators who have received this union demand for Monday alosing have offered their butcher employees the same increased wages and the shorter work week without Monday closing which have been accepted by six other Southern California butcher unions. Frank Kresnesky is a hold-out. He insists upon closing markets from 6:00 P.M. Saturday until 9:00 A.M. Tuesday.

Weges and hours are proper subject for union negotiations. The days a store remains apen to serve customers is not a proper subject for union negotiation.

EMPLOYERS HAVE OFFERED A 5-DAY WORK WEEK WITH INCREASED PAY

During the past year, journeymen butchers have been paid $\$ 60$ for a 48 hour work week ( $\$ 1.25$ per hour)-an $80 \%$ increase over hourly rates paid in 1941. In a sincere effort to negotiate a new, workable contract, market operators
have offered $\$ 66$ pay for a 5 day, 40 hour work week ( $\$ 1.65$ per hour) with time and a half ( $\$ 2.471 / 2$ per hour) for all hours worked over 40: This is an increase of $32 \%$ over wage rates in the expiring contract.
