Of the 468,200 individuals holding the common and preferred stock of companies in the steel industry, 232,000 are women, according to an American Iron and Steel Institute survey of companies operating 91 percent of the nation's steel capacity. Male stockholders total 235,700, and in addition there are 47,900 institutions, businesses and other groups owning a share of the industry. Individual stockholders total total continuation of the industry stock, while 9.0 percent was held by institutions, including insurance companies, hospitals, colleges, churches, charities, foundations and estates. Other groups, including small and large businesses, investment trusts, foreign corporations, brokerage houses and so on, held 31.0 percent.

ployment for (3,319 people in the steel industry and its corolary activities.

Operations of the steel industry in 1946 resulted in earnings of \$179,653,823, which represented less than 5 per cent return to the owners of the industry for their investment. For every dollar of dividends paid to the owners of the industry in 1946, employees in the industry were paid \$16.50 in the form of salaries or wages. The average for all businesses is seven dollars to wage earners for every dollar paid out to investors. If the dividends paid to steel stockholders for the years from 1934 through 1945 were combined, the total would be only one-half of last year's payroll.
