Wilmington Hall To Be Opened To Single Workers

Through agreement between the City Housing Commission, the Mayor's Emergency Housing Committee, and the A F of L Building Trades Council, the closed single men's dormitories at Wilmington Hall, located at, 435 Neptune st., in Wilmington, will be re-opened for occupancy by single, in-migrant building trades workers in a select category of critical skills, it was announced today by Nicola Giulii, chairman of the City Housing Commission. The new order takes effect immediately.

At the same time, appplicants for living quarters at Wilmington Hall will be taken from single male veterans of World War II, whether they are construction workers or not. Rates will be \$4.50 per week, per person, in a double room, and \$5.50 per week in a single room.

Purpose of providing living quarters for in-migrant workers is to attract enough skilled mechanics from the east and mid-
