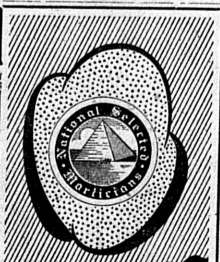

McMaster said firemen rolled to the scene at 2 a. m. and, after breaking the lock on the door of the store, blinding smoke mingled with the outside fog to black-out the entire area around.

No loss was reported from the smoke and fumes at the liquor store. Neither were any package items missing, an observer reported after noting the police watching the firemen and the firemen watching the police.

Too Late To Stop Purchase Of Pipe, Walterians Told

Efforts of Walteria to delay the purchase of pipe for construction of the water main from Walnut street in Lomita to Walteria, to transport Metropolitan water for the new Southwest Torrance water district, are too late, it was revealed Tuesday night.

The City Council was told by Water Manager William Stanger that half of the pipe already is here and that it is too late to cancel the order.

A 16,000-foot line will be constructed to transport the Metropolitan supply, but the delay was asked because of the prospective construction of a similar line to serve Redondo Beach and other South Bay cities.
