earry? Not less than \$1,000,
not more than \$10,000 and any
amount in between in multiples
of \$500.
Types of policies to choose The veteran and his NSLL

Types of policies to choose from: Since the new law amending NSLI became effective Feb. 21, 1947, initial application may be made for any one of the seven authorized plans. Before this law initial applications could be made for 5-year level term policies only and the insured would have to wait one year before being permitted to convert to one of the other policies.

Five-year level, or term insurance, is actual cost insurance. It affords maximum protection at the lowest cost. However, there is only a few cents per thous an d accumulated or accrued value. It has no loan value. The difference a veteran pays between 5-year level and any one of the other policies represents approximately the cash surrender value of his new policy. To illustrate: a \$10,000 5-year level policy will cost a veteran \$8.70 per month and a 30-payment policy for the same amount at the same age will cost \$16.70 per menth; a difference of \$10.00. This \$10.00 represents the approximate saving he has made per month.

Payments to beneficiaries may be made in lump sum or in monthly installments ranging from 36 to 240 months. To illustrate: If a veteran wants his beneficiary will be paid \$28.99 per thousand of insurance per month; 48 months—\$22.06; 60—\$17.91, etc.
