# Formation Of Torrance Educational WATER DEPARTMENT PROFITS **Council To Be Suggested To Board**

Formation of a Torrance Educational Council, consisting of representatives of various organizations within the city, will be suggested to the Torrance City Board or Education, according to Superintendent of Schools J. H. Hull.

The superintendent said that the Council is desirable that many community-school problems might have full discussion. "Through the operation of an Educational Council in the community," Superintendent Hull said, "the schools can be kept informed of the desires of the community and the organizations as represented on the Council can be kept informed about the workings of the schools."

He suggested that it meet periodically, perhaps once each month, and that it consist of one representative of each of the service clubs, veterans organizations, lodges, Ministerial Association, Parent-Teacher Council, the press, a member of the City Council, Chamber of Convinerce, Women's clubs and patriotic groups. In all, he estimated the Council would have a membership of approximately 25 persons. A member of the Board of Education and the superintendent also would sit on the Council.
