Despite a decrease in water levels in the underground storage basins and in reservoirs, there will be plenty of water for irrigation purposes in Los Angeles County this summer, Supervisor William A. Smith predicted.

Smith said there were 23,000 agre feet of water now in storage reservoirs as compared with 45,000, acre feet at this time last year. Of, the total 19,000 acre feet is available in Dam No. 11 in San Gabriel Canyon.

Smith, who is chairman of the Board of Supervisors' flood control committee, has completed a study of various underground basins in the county. Their levels are lower than last year. Chickenpox **Explained By Health Officer**

Chickenpox is a common communicable disease transmitted from person to person through discharges from the mouth, nose and skin lesions. Although in ancient times it was confused with smallpox, modern medicine finds it has no connection what ever—in fact, smallpox vaccination gives no immunity against chickenpox.

The incubation period is usually from two to three weeks and the disease is more prevalent in children although adults may contract it. It usually begins with feverishness, loss of appetite, aching and vomiting, followed within 24 hours by small, raised rose-pink spots which change into blisters. These in turn form crusts which drop off of their own accord. The crusts are not contagious.

Although the disease is not quarantinable in California, patients should be kept in bed, isolated from contact with those who have not had it. Scratching or picking at the blisters may cause serious sores and disfiguring sears. The physician may suggest a mild lotion or ointment for the relief of itching.

Complications are rare, though pitting or scarring the skin is not uncommon to scratching. Secondary in tigo can also develop. St sanitary precautions should taken in the nursing care of patient.

Needless Alarm By Motorists In **Fuel Shortage**

"It is my belief that certain reports that military demands will cause civilian shortages have caused unnecessary concern," he said. "So far as we can see there will be ample supplies of gasoline for automobile owners planning trips anywhere in the Pacific west, It is also our feeling that there will be sufficient supplies of heating and furnace oils for 1947.48 winter season."
