Small job allowance for resi-dential construction, repairs and altérations without permit from the FHA has been raised from \$400 to \$1000, McGovern stated. Holders of permits issued since Dec 24, 1946 and prior to June 1, 1947, are automatically au-thorized to do any additional construction in connection with dwellings covered by such per-mits which would be authorized under the provisions of HPR as amended June 2, 1947. The FHA will continue to pro-cess requests for approval of maximum rentals as in the past-except that in order to obtain such approval a builder need only submit a letter, in tripli-cate, accompanied by one set of plans and outline specifications stating the proposed maximum rent for each family unit con-structed under HPR, not later than 30 days before the esti-mated time of completion of the project.
