Warning Issued Against Fireworks

A warning was issued this week by Fire Chief McMaster to the children and merchants of Torrance pertaining to the use and sale of fireworks in the city.

McMaster quoted City Ordinance 185, effective since May 29, 1929, which says: "It shall be unlawful for any person to offer for sale, or to ignite or discharge any fireworks of any kind, at any time, in the City of Torrance, except on the first four days of July in each year, except that the Chief of the Fire Department may issue special permits for display of fireworks at such other times, and at such places, as he may deem will not endanger life or property."

Pointing out the fact that several fires have recently been caused by the use of fireworks, the chief stated that the Ordinance will be strictly enforced.

Reasons For Withdrawing Bill Told By Vincent Thomas

Assemblyman Vincent Thomas, who represents Torrance and the Harbor district in the Assembly, said Friday that the reason he decided not to press for passage of Assembly Bill 14, which would simplify requirements for a secession vote by residents of San Pedro, Wilmington and the Shoestring strip of Los Angeles, was the circulation of a letter from San Pedro Chamber of Commerce among the 80 members of the Assembly. The letter, he said, disputed the veracity of Thomas' statements on the floor of the Assembly and created "sufficient confusion" among the members of the Assembly that it was impossible to round up enough votes to pass the measure.

Candidates For Jobs At T. H. S. Interviewed Here

Candidates for positions at the Torrance high school will be interviewed at the City Board of Education offices, 2093 Torrance boulevard, next Monday afternoon, June 23, from 2 to 6 o'clock.

Positions are open as gardeners, janitors, maintenance men and night watchmen and clerical and secretarial help.

Cafeteria workers will be employed later during the summer months. W. K. Cobb, superintendent of the Redondo Union high school district announced that offices at the Torrance high school will be open all summer and that dates for preliminary registration of students will be announced later.

Cobb further announced that purchase of equipment and supplies and text books for the Torrance high school is under way and he is very confident that everything will be in order for the beginning of school the middle of September.

Special Classes For Handicapped

Torrance will make provisions for handling all physically handicapped children of the community, the Board of Education decided Tuesday night.

A list of those needing attention will be compiled between now and Sept. 1. If the number needing special attention is sufficient to warrant special teachers and classes, they will be provided. Otherwise, a contract may be made with the Los Angeles City schools under an offer submitted by Verling Kersey, it was announced.
