Fund Allowed For Sepulveda Street Bridge

Funds for the construction of bridges across the Los Angeles river at Long Beach Blvd. and Willow (Sepulveda) street, have been approved by the County Board of Supervisors for allocation from District Oil Well operations in the City of Long Beach, according to announcement by Supervisor Raymond V. Darby, chairman of the Board. The City of Long Beach requested financial assistance last December for the building of a permanent bridge across the Los Angeles river and an agreement was entered into whereby the Flood Control District was to immediately allocate all unencumbered net oil revenue funds which had accumulated to Jan. 1, 1947, amounting to \$123,662.64. The unencumbered net revenue, said Supervisor Darby, from this source from Jan. 1, 1947 to June 30, 1947, estimated at \$47,000 was to be allocated after July 1, 1947, and is the money called for under the new allocation.
