ORDINANCE NO. 389
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, GRANTING TO STANDARD GAS COMPANY, AN IDAHO CORPORATION, A FRANCHISE TO LAY, CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN, OPERATE, REPAIR, RENEW, CHANGE THE SIZE OF, AND REMOVE PIPE LINES FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF OIL, PETROLEUM, GAS, GASOLINE, WATER OR OTHER SUBSTANCES, IN, UNDER, ALONG AND ACROSS CERTAIN PUBLIC STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND ALLEYS IN SAID CITY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
SECTION 1. There is hereby granted to Standard Gas Company, an Idaho corporation, authorized to transport and transact business in the State of California, the franchise and privilege to lay and construct, and for a period of one year from and after the date of passage of the ordinance granting such franchise and privilege, to install, repair, renew, change the size of and remove pipe lines, and to erect, install, gas, gasoline, water or other substances, or any thereof, in, under, along and across the public streets, highways and alleys (hereinafter referred to as "highways") in said City of Torrance.

SECTION 2. This franchise is granted to Standard Gas Company, only upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, and shall only be within thirty (30) days after the date of the passage of this ordinance with the City Council of the City of Torrance, in written acceptance of such terms and conditions.

SECTION 3. The term "grantee" whenever used herein shall be held to mean and signify the grantee or its successors or assigns.

SECTION 4. The grantee shall maintain such traps, manholes, conduits, valves, and other appurtenances in, under, along and across the public streets, highways and alleys (hereinafter referred to as "highways") as may be necessary or convenient for the proper maintenance and repair of such pipes, conduits, valves, traps, manholes, conduits, and appurtenances.

SECTION 5. So far as is practicable, all pipe lines shall be located along the edge or shoulder of the highway or on any other place which does not finally disturb the flow of traffic and which is most convenient to the use of the highway.

SECTION 6. The pipe lines and appurtenances shall be constructed and maintained in a workmanlike manner and in conformity with all the ordinances and rules of the City of Torrance, and the City Engineer of said City, and the grantee shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of Torrance and from any and all damages resulting from the construction, maintenance, repair or operation under this franchise.

SECTION 7. If any portion of any pipe line shall be damaged by reason of breaks or leaks in any pipe or conduit constructed under this franchise, the grantee shall, at its own expense, immediately follow-up and repair such damage and put such highway in as good condition as it was in before such break or leak, to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of Streets or City Engineer of said City.

SECTION 8. If any portion of any pipe line shall be damaged by reason of breaks or leaks in any pipe or conduit constructed under this franchise, the grantee shall, at its own expense, immediately follow-up and repair such damage and put such highway in as good condition as it was in before such break or leak, to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of Streets or City Engineer of said City.

Limits of the City of Torrance at present, and shall be subject to the City of Torrance, California, Granting to Standard Gas Company, an Idaho Corporation, a franchise to lay, construct, maintain, operate, repair, renew, change the size of, and remove pipe lines for the transportation of oil, petroleum, gas, gasoline or other substances, in, under, along and across certain public streets, highways and alleys in said City.

SECTION 1. There is hereby granted to Standard Gas Company, an Idaho corporation, authorized to transport and transact business in the State of California, the franchise and privilege to lay and construct, and for a period of one year from and after the date of passage of the ordinance granting such franchise and privilege, to install, repair, renew, change the size of and remove pipe lines, and to erect, install, gas, gasoline, water or other substances, or any thereof, in, under, along and across the public streets, highways and alleys (hereinafter referred to as "highways") in said City of Torrance.

SECTION 2. This franchise is granted to Standard Gas Company, only upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, and shall only be within thirty (30) days after the date of the passage of this ordinance with the City Council of the City of Torrance, in written acceptance of such terms and conditions.

SECTION 3. The term "grantee" whenever used herein shall be held to mean and signify the grantee or its successors or assigns.

SECTION 4. The grantee shall maintain such traps, manholes, conduits, valves, and other appurtenances in, under, along and across the public streets, highways and alleys (hereinafter referred to as "highways") as may be necessary or convenient for the proper maintenance and repair of such pipes, conduits, valves, traps, manholes, conduits, and appurtenances.

SECTION 5. So far as is practicable, all pipe lines shall be located along the edge or shoulder of the highway or on any other place which does not finally disturb the flow of traffic and which is most convenient to the use of the highway.

SECTION 14. Said grantee shall not sell or assign this franchise, or the rights or privileges granted therein, without the consent of the City Council, nor shall this franchise be sold or assigned except by a duly executed instrument in writing filed in the office of the City Council of said City of Torrance, and nothing in this franchise contained shall be construed to grant to said grantee any right to sell or assign this franchise, or any of the rights or privileges therein granted, except in the manner aforesaid.

SECTION 15. Upon any neglect, failure or refusal of the grantee to comply with any of the conditions of this franchise, said City by its City Council may declare this franchise forfeited, and may exclude said grantee from further use of the highways of said City under this franchise, and said grantee shall thereupon surrender all rights in and to this franchise, and it shall be deemed and shall remain null, void and of no effect.

SECTION 16. The grantor or any successor maintain and control hereafter formed, shall have the right after one year after the date of the ordinance granting this franchise, to acquire the property and the rights of the grantee, or any portion thereof, constructed, acquired or operated under this franchise, upon making reasonable compensation therefor to the grantee, as determined by the City Council.

SECTION 17. This franchise is granted subject to the further condition that the grantee shall, at all times during the life of this franchise, keep on file with the City Clerk of said City, a regular statement showing the total gross receipts of said grantee, during the preceding twelve (12) months, from the use, operation or possession of such pipes, conduits, valves, traps, manholes, conduits, and appurtenances, and within ten (10) days after the time for filing the statement of said grantee, to the City Treasurer of said City of Torrance the payment provided for in the preceding paragraph hereof.
