The Torrance Heraid and Lomita. News and other newspapers in the Los Angeles area today received expressions of appreciation for their support of the Veterans Administration's current GI Insurance' campaign from Duke H. Bennett, VA public relations chief for the Los Angeles Regional office.

As a result of the cooperation received by the VA from the press, radio, veteran organizations, religious and chie groups and the general public, the Los Angeles Regional office has reinstated 75,000 GI insurance policies totaling \$600,000,000 during the past 12 months, Bennett said. Most of these reinstatements have been made since the GI in Sur an c e information campaign started February 3, 1947.

World War II veterans have only 34 days left to reinstate lapsed government insurance by making a comparative health statement that they are in as good health today as when their policies lapsed, and payment of two monthly premiums. After August 1, 1947, Bennett explained, physical examinations will be required where policies have lapsed more than three months.

Quarantine Of Beach Modified By Health Dept.

Modification of the beach quarantine in Los Angeles County has been announced by the State Department of Public Health, according to Dr. Roy O. Gilbert, Los Angeles County Health officer.

Boundaries of the prohibited zone now extend from Sunset pier in Venice forming the northern boundary of the quarantine area to 27th street in Manhattan Beach forming the southern boundary. All beaches within these limits remain under quarantine but the public may enjoy the beaches north and south of the quarantine but the public may enjoy the beaches north and south of the quarantine or signally extended to Seaside Terrace in Santa Monica on the north and to 14th street in Hermosa Beach on the south.
