Poison Oak **Warning Given** By Dr. Gilbert

Poison oak remin's most peo-ple of painful experiences to be avoided, yet many do not recog-nize the plant when they see it. ple of painful experiences to be avoided, yet many do not recognize the plant when they see it. Learning to recognize it on sight is relatively easy if one closely examines the distinctive identifying characteristics of the plant. There is then a good chance to avoid it or, if one must work among it, to take oreventive measures to escape poisoning. The most characteristic feature of the plant is that the leaves always consist of three leaflets arising from a common stem.

The old proverb, "an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure" is good advice to everyone particularly as regards poison oak. Previous escape is not proof of immunity when conditions arright, and after poisoning occurs there is no quick cure known. Some relief may be obtained and recovery hastened by use of some of the tested remedies. In case of severe poisoning a physician should be consulted.

If one cares to take some preliminary precautions a gainst poison oak, probably the best protection is afforded by a rich after of yellow laundry soap allowed to dry on the skin before going into the fields or woods. At the end of the trip the removal of this soary protective film is an easy matter and it is well worth the trouble.

The most effective method of prevention is to eradicate the plants and wherever possible this should be done. 2.4-D is a hormone-like chemical, which has proved effective in readicating poison oak. With 2.4-D and other chemical agents, commercial companies engaged in weed control are now ready to guarantee complete eradication of this plant.

Brothers Jailed For Resisting Arrest, Battery
