Elementary School Boundries Awaiting Local Board Approval

Tentative boundaries for children attending the four elementary schools within Torrance, have been set and now await approval of the school board at its next regular meeting Aug. 5.

Perry school will draw pupils living within the area enclosed by Redondo Beach blvd. on the north, west to Hawthorne ave., south to 182nd st., west to Inglewood ave., south to 190th st., west to Susana st., south to Huntington, east along Huntington st. and the Santa Fe railroad to Western ave., north on Western ave. to 174th st., west to Illinois st., north to Redondo Beach blvd.

Settlement Of Fulmer Lawsuit Is Announced

Superior Court Judge Ben Rosenthal Thursday approved a compromise settlement to dispose of a \$105,000,000 damage suit brought by 4-year-old Kenneth Wayne Fulmer against the Maywood Hospital and Clinic for alleged bungling of a hand injury.

The suit was filed by the boy's father, Robert V. Fulmer, 37, mechanic and his wife Ruby E. Fulmer, 31, 20826 Shearer ave., Torrance.

It was charged that the hospital was careless in treating the boy's hand, which had been burned at their former home, 1156 E. 56th st., when a gauze bandage caught fire near the incinerator.

The complaint states that after ten days' treatment the boy lost the ends of his fingers on the left hand, and two months later the fingers and thumb grew together into the shape of a ball. His parents claim four operations will be required to separate the fingers.

Under the settlement, \$3,000 will be paid by the hospital, \$1,631 of which will go to the father as guardian of the boy. The latter sum is to be deposited with the Bank of America and no withdrawals can be made without approval of the court.
