Acquired through the War Assets Administration last June, the 88-arc tract and its 60 buildings is now a fully equipped unit of the Los Angeles County Hospital system. A staff of 500 enables the hospital to handle the 550 beds now in use and to assist the hard pressed emergency agencies in the area.

The hospital exists primarily for the purpose of providing care and treatment to those persons who are financially unable to bear such costs. No cases are

to bear such costs. No cases are refused, however, if conditions are such that adequate and prompt care cannot be given

State Residents prompt care cannot be given elsewhere.

Now under way is the conversion to wards of the former army barracks on the tract for the care of tubercular, bed patients. The new wards, designed to hold 114 beds, will cost \$50.000 and will enable the hospital to render complete tubercular aid to emergency and acute cases in the area.

Serving a large part of Los Angeles County, the boundaries of the Harbor General hospital's jurisdiction stretch from Rosecrans blvd, south and west of Figueroa st. to Victoria ave, eastward along an imaginary projection to the county line, thus enclosing territory surrounding Long Beach and the whole harbor area.

At present an average of 15 patients are admitted each day and an additional 20 are related to provide general classystem of the statement was made to drom the Chief Superintedent of Grounds and Buildings that 351.000 square feet of temporary classroom, laboratory and office space will be ready for occurancy on the eight campuses by September, 1947.
