12) Now that time limitations on the G.I. Bill started on July 25, 1947, the last, day veterans may register for unemployment allowance is July 25, 1949, and all payments will cease July 25, 1952. Those in service pow and whose enlistment started prior to July 25, of this year will be eligible to apply for the allowance any time up to two years after separation from their present enlistment. However, all payments will cease five years from July 25, 1947, or on July 25, 1952.

(3) Employed veterans may register with the California State Employment Service now or before July 25, 1949, to protect themselves against the possibility of unemployment before this five year payment period is up. In other words, a veteran to be eligible for the allowance after July 25, 1949, must be registered with that agency before that date.

Answer: Every day if you die. However, children under 15 cears of age are generally retrieted from visiting in VA genral, surgical, tuberculosis, and deuropsychiatric hospitals, except in special cases and then only with the consent of the loctors in charge.


