**Veterans May Get Small Cut In Assignment To Second Division Assessed Value Of County Told**

Initial assignments to the famed Second Infantry Division, commanded by Major General Paul W. Kendall at Fort Lewis, Wash., are now open according to the U. S. Army Recruiting station located in the Chamber of Commerce building, Torrance.

Veterans of any of the armed forces are eligible and are assured of a duty tour of a minimum of one year within the 6th Army area. It was further stated that vacancies exist in 93 different Military Occupational Specialties in grades ranging from private through technical sergeant.

Interested veterans are advised to apply at the recruiting office without delay.

**County Saves Million In War Surplus Buys**

Purchase of needed items of war surplus equipment and materials by the County has resulted in a saving of more than one million dollars, Supervisor Leonard J. Roach disclosed today.

Roach pointed out that the cost of the county is less than the total amount saved, in discussing the report for the period ending July 31, 1947. He said that the items purchased at a cost of \$785,683 have a value of \$1,828,604, thereby affording a saving to taxpayers of \$1,042,921.

**School Traffic Warning Issued By Vehicle Chief**

The warning cry of "Back to School, Watch Out for Children," soon will be heard throughout California it was announced today by the Department of Motor Vehicles as the American Legion pledged its support to a joint accident prevention program to continue during September.

Formal approval of the plan was voted at the last meeting of the Legion Executive Committee and conferences on details have been held by Edgar E. Lampton, director of Motor Vehicles, and W. A. Huggins, Chief of the State Bureau of Accident Prevention. All of the 819 posts of the Legion in California will be brought into the picture to cover every school in the state, Huggins advised Lampton.

"The first part of each school year is the most dangerous, and we want to warn everyone to be alert at all times when children may be going to and from school or to and from playgrounds," Lampton announced. "The Highway Patrol will pay particular attention to schools in unincorporated areas and we know other law enforcement agencies will be active in cities and towns."

Lampton urged parents to warn their children of highway dangers while walking or riding bicycles.
