DREDGE FOR LOWER COLORADO ORDERED King Presents **Revolver To** Truman

Rep. Cecil R. King, who represents Torrance and the Harbor district in Washington, has presented President Truman with the first 38 ealiber service revolver turned out by the Smith & Wesson Firearms Co., for World War II.
Carrying the serial No. VI the revolver was the first of 1,412,000 sidearms manufactured by the firm for the armed forces during the war. King's collection of firearms is considered to be one of the finest in the country.

The most enthusatic gun collector on Capitol Hill, King said the President expressed "great delight" when the presentation was made:
