Community Aid in Recruiting For CNG Asked

Lt. Col. Myron E. Page, Jr., Corps of Engineers instructor for the 578th Engineer Combat Battalion, California National Guard, this week appealed for greater community support for recruiting in the National Guard.

"The new National Guard is designed as a very important part of the Army of the United States, and it will be composed of volunteer soldiers, on a part-time basis trained to take the field at a moment's notice in event of emergency," Col. Page said. Communities such as Torrance which have been assigned National Guard units can consider themselves fortunate, he declared, and should lend their aid to the recruiting effort of the units.

"The National Guard has a long, tough job ahead in recruiting," Colonel Page said, "and any assistance the community can offer will be returned a hundred fold."

Colonel Page is residing at Seaside Ranchos and took over his assignment as regular Army instructor for the Corps of Engineers at the 578th headquarters on Torrance Municipal Airport on August 1.

Applications For Amusement Units Now Available

Those who apply for authority to construct should ask for four copies of Form OHE 14-171, one copy of the fact sheet, and one copy of the Construction Limitation Regulation. The material is self-explanatory, easy to fill in, and when completed should be addressed to the Housing Expediter, Washington 25, D. C.

L.A. Schools Win Fight On Church Services Denial

The State Supreme Court has upheld the Los Angeles Board of Education in its refusal to open the Lincoln High School for evangelical services to Christ for Greater Los Angeles, Inc.

The corporation sought a writ of mandate to compel the board to open the school to it. The board and the Appellate Court turned it down on grounds provided by the State Constitution which says neither the State Legislature nor a school district may grant anything, or any aid, to a religious sect, church, creed or sectarian purpose.

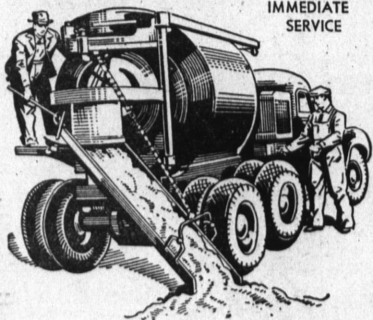
