The Ladies Guild of the Central Evangelical church will sponsor a turkey dinner tomorrow night from 5 to 7 o'clock.

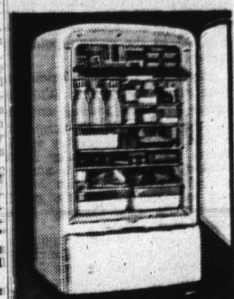
TORRANCE OBSERVES NATIONAL 'Y' DAY FOR FIRST TIME TONIGHT
