Changes Noted In **NSLI** Clauses **On Beneficiary**

Many veterans who took out National Service Life Insurance some time ago will find it ad-visable to reconsider the desig-nation of beneficiaries of their

policies, according to James G. Caldwell, director of the Torrance Area Veterains Service Center, since restrictions on the naming of beneficiaries have been lifted. The veterar now may designate any person or persons, firm, corporation, or other legal entity, including his estate, as the principal beneficiary or beneficiaries under his policy, either individually or as a trustee. Formerly, only close relatives could be named.

Circumstances such as the death of a beneficiary, marriage divorce, or birth of a child usual ly call for a change in the naming of a beneficiary, yet in many cases nothing has been done by the veteran to take care of this vital matter.
