## County Plans Beach Work At Redondo

An extensive improvement of the county-owned beach extending from the Torrance City line near avenue I northward to Knob Hill ave. in Redondo Beach, is contemplated.

Preparation of plans for the above work has been referred to the chief mechanical engineer, who has retained the services of an outside architect in order that the project may be expedited, Wimmer revealed.

The matter of making the preliminary surveys for the proposed improvement has been referred to the county surveyor, Wimmer said. The surveys are now in progress.

In addition, the matter of sewerage disposal for the area has been referred to the county engineer for study and recommendation.

Definite plans for the improvement will not be made until after the preliminary surveys have been completed and mapped, it was revealed.

It was suggested that the treatment along the top of the slope now under consideration by the city of Redondo Beach could be coordinated with the county proposed improvement plan at the time the county project reaches the proper stage of development.

Since the county took possession of the beach, approximately 10 years ago, installation of a comfort station at the foot of Sapphire st. has been the only improvement to date.
