



Freeway Program Brings Differences Of Opinion

Build freeways first where vehicular traffic is heaviest, members of the State Highway Commission were urged recently night at a meeting of the Metropolitan Traffic and Transit Committee of the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce. 1. Set up a new and adequate system of traffic checks to determine priorities in construction of forthcoming freeways. 2. Start surveying the first priority routes in the metropolitan area so the people may know where the freeways are to be located. 3. Budget funds for the next fiscal year for completion of

work now under way—the Santa Ana-Hollywood Parkway, the Harbor Parkway southward from the Arroyo Seco, and for engineering and designing of the Inglewood and Santa Monica parkways. At the same hearing, opposition was voiced by spokesmen for South Side residents against the proposed location of the Harbor Freeway. Gregory Cruzet, representing the Southside Chamber of Commerce, told the Commission that a freeway between Broadway and Figueroa st. from Santa Barbara st. to San Pedro would mean the elimination of from 15,000 to 20,000 homes.
