

THE DRAMA OF OIL

Some people have wondered why American oil companies have assumed much of the leadership in developing the oil resources of other countries—and just what interest the American citizen has in this work.

The reason isn't hard to find. Oil is a vital instrument of world recovery and world development—the success of the Marshall Plan, for instance, is largely dependent on adequate oil supplies. The American oil industry is superbly equipped with the engineering know-how, and all the human and financial resources that are needed to put the oil resources of remote lands to use. And, finally, domestic consumption of oil has reached so high a level, and is expected to go far higher still, that it is obviously necessary to make the rest of the world as nearly self-sufficient in oil as possible.

The largest and most dramatic new development is in the Middle East, where, in time, the Arabian fields will be able to take care of the needs of Europe. Another very important development is under way in New Guinea, where an intense search for crude is being made to serve the growing requirements of the oil-hungry Far-East. As one expert puts the problem, "Oilmen are struggling to make every world area more dependent on sources near at home." The World supply-demand balance is delicate, and more oil is the only answer.
